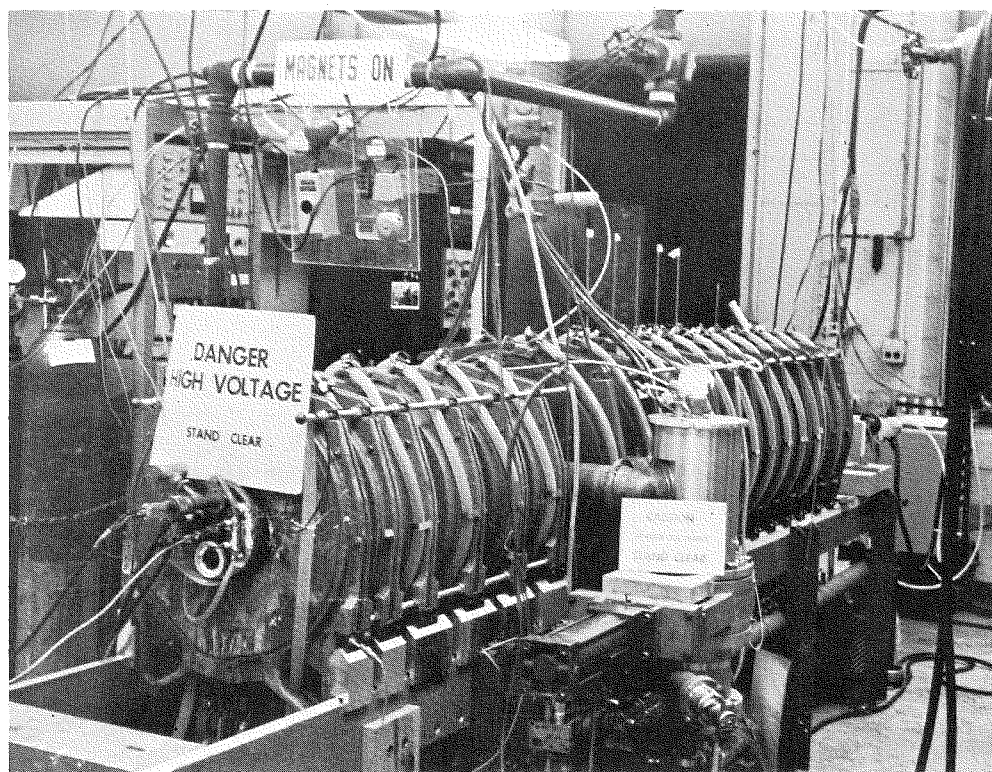
To the Class of '82,
